**POLICE COMMISSION MEETING  
8 March 2010**

**CTO**

Commissioner Matt Mason called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m. In attendance were Commissioners Mark Ketley, Chris Weldon, Chief Michael Lombardo, Deputy Chief Robert Crosby.

**MINUTES**

A motion made by Commissioner Ketley was seconded by Commissioner Mason to approve the Minutes of the February 10, 2010 Special Meeting. So moved 3-0.

**DISUCSSION OF MONTHLY REPORTS**

The Commission reviewed, discussed and accepted the monthly reports.

Chief Lombardo expressed concern that the number of *MV Stops* is down considerably compared with February 2009, but shows an increase over last month's numbers. This continues to be monitored closely.

Domestic Violence was discussed and the Commission noted there was a decrease in Domestic Violence calls this past month.

- Email from Chief Lombardo commending Officer William Barrett on his motor vehicle activity for the week of February 15, 2010.
- Email from Chief Lombardo conveying Weston Police Chief Troxell's gratitude to Sgt. David Collins, Officers David Hartman and Diane Papa for assistance on a call.
- The STP Report was reviewed and discussed.
- Chief Lombardo had *Kids in Crisis* come in and train the supervisory staff.
- An Officer is being sent to *Method of Instruction* in an attempt to limit outside training and reduce training costs.
